Notes: Phelps swam qualifying fly leg on 400 medley relay in 2003, Crocker swimming in finals Team set world-record en route to gold.

In 2005, Phelps swam on gold medal-winning 800 free relay and fly leg in qualifying for 400 medley relay. Again Crocker swam in finals, team winning gold .

In 2007, Phelps swam on gold medal-winning 400-800 free relays, with latter setting a world-record en route to the title. Likely would have won a record seventh gold via 400 medley relay but team was disqualified in prelims for a false start.
